Dear Friends,

We live in a world of extremes. So often, choices are framed as either-or, when in reality, life is far more nuanced.

Economic Status: We frequently hear about growing income inequality, leading us to believe people are either ultra-wealthy or living in extreme poverty. But most people live somewhere in or near the middle class, navigating varying degrees of financial stability throughout life's seasons.

Mental Health: Conversations around mental health are often presented in absolutes—a person is either "mentally healthy" or struggling with severe illness. Yet mental health exists on a spectrum. Many of us experience periods of stress, anxiety, or sadness without having a formal diagnosis, reflecting the complex realities we all face.

Parenting Styles: Parenting debates often focus on "helicopter parents" (over-controlling) versus "free-range parents" (overly permissive). But most parents blend approaches, being protective in some areas and encouraging independence in others, based on context and their child's unique needs.

Faith: Faith, too, is often cast in black and white terms—you either have Jesus or you don't. But for many, both inside and outside the church, faith is a journey lived in tension between belief and doubt, curiosity and certainty. Moments of strong faith can coexist with deep questions, sometimes in the very same breath.

These are just a few examples, but the list goes on. As we approach Easter, our Bible readings will focus on common faith issues that are often presented as either-or choices. But Scripture invites us to see these issues in their full complexity. This Lent, we'll explore that richness through our series titled *"Everything in Between"*—a collaboration with *A Sanctified Art*.

Life isn't black and white. It's filled with nuance, uncertainty, and complexity—and it's often in the in-between spaces that we encounter God most deeply.

If you find yourself navigating gray areas in your life and long for a faith that engages the real tensions of the world rather than avoiding them, Lake Shore Church is the place to be over the next two months. I hope you'll join us.

On March 11 we will be preparing and serving dinner to the 50 women and children enrolled in the MCREST program. We are doing this in partnership with Triumphant Cross Church, SCS, as they take on a hosting week. We have been partnering with them for the last 8 years.

Through MCREST the women and children are being housed in the MCREST apartment building in Mt Clemens. They are being helped with managing their finances, finding permanent housing, and other social services. MCREST is working to help them help themselves.

The men enrolled in the MCREST program (the ones we are making sandwiches for the week), are currently being housed in motels in SCS, Roseville, and Mt Clemens. Eventually they will be housed in an apartment building next door to the current MCREST building.

Blessing Bags


